□ Fund Release Process:

BENEFICIARY LGU

- Complies and submits the fund release requirements



DBM CO

- Evaluates and issues SARO to BTr and NCA to GSB



BTr

- Prepares the ADA and issues the NADAI to beneficiary LGUs

Local Government Support Fund - Assistance to Cities “Green, Green, Green”

- Treated as a trust fund
- Funds which remain unutilized as of December 31, 2019 shall be returned to the National Treasury
- Implement by administration or by contract, and in accordance with the design, plan, specifications and such other standards and policies of the National Government

Local Government Support Fund - Assistance to Cities “Green, Green, Green”

MOVING FORWARD....

- Sustain the Assistance to the Cities for Open Space Development
 - Review the allocation formula to provide for equalization factors
 - Provide technical assistance to cities
